



Travel to the International Wolf Center

Participants are responsible for their own transportation to Ely. Once at Timber Trail Lodge, transport for all programming will be provided. The final day's programming presumes participants will transport themselves to the International Wolf Center. If participants do not have transportation this day from the lodge to the Center, it will be provided.

Airports

Most airline flights within Minnesota are provided by Northwest Airlines. Northwest Airlines provides a flight availability search engine for your convenience. Following is additional information.

- Minneapolis (MSP), 240 miles to Ely. Rental cars available at airport.
- Duluth (DLH), approximately 115 miles to Ely. Rental cars available at airport.
- Hibbing/Chisholm (HIB), approximately 75 miles to Ely. Rental cars available at airport.
- Ely (LYU), 6 miles to Ely. No commercial service. No rental cars. Taxi service available, see below.

Driving Directions

There are two main Highways that access Ely: Highway 169 and Highway 1.

- Highway 169 is an east-west highway considered to be more direct and may be accessed:
 - From the south by Highway 53 (north through Virginia)
 - From the north by Highway 53 (south from International Falls)
- Highway 1 is a north-south highway considered to be more scenic and may be accessed:
 - From the south by Highway 61 (via Interstate 35)
 - From the north by Highway 61 (down from Canada)

The International Wolf Center is located on the east side of Ely on the south side of the highway.

*If you are traveling by car from Minneapolis to Ely, note that it is about 240 miles, taking approximately 4 hours and 30 minutes.

Follow Highway 169 east past the International Wolf Center approximately 1 mile. Turn right on the Kawishiwi Trail and follow approximately 6 miles. Turn Left into Timber Trail Lodge main driveway and check in at the main lodge, which is the second building on the left.

The earliest check-in at Timber Trail Lodge is 2:00 p.m. You are welcome to check in at the International Wolf Center however, our hours of operation change seasonally. Please check www.wolf.org for current hours. If you visit the Center during business hours, mention that you are participating in the Family Dogsled program for free admission.
